

## Hoggard HS: Freshman Course Sequencing Examples

### Typical with no HS courses completed

Honors English 1 or English 1

Honors Math 1 or Math 1

Honors Earth Science or Earth Science

Honors World History or World History

Health/PE

3 electives

\*\*Wait to take World Language until sophomore year unless student has exemplary academic background

### Adjustments for HS courses completed online or in classroom

- If student has taken Earth Science and has done well-*Honors Biology*
- If student has taken Math 1 and has done well (high 80s or above)-*Honors Math 2*
- If student has taken World History and has done well-*Honors Civics*
- If student has taken an online American History course-*Honors World*.  
\*\*American History sequence will be completed later, as students may choose to take AP US History later. American History/AP US History classes in high school are 99.9% comprised of juniors.
- If student has taken English 1-*Will retake as Honors English 1 if Pre-DP*.  
\*\*Highly encourage retake on Honors level to prepare for Honors English 2. Any other sequence (Honors English 2) should be requested directly by MS counselors to HS. Five-year plan for English must be created by the HS.
- Use teacher recommendations to determine Honors vs. on level.

### Typical pre-DP with and without HS courses

Honors English 1-paired with Hon Civics for yearlong A/B schedule

Honors Biology, may not be able to double up\*

Math or Honors Math, appropriate level, may not be able to double up

Health/PE

World Language Level 1

World Language Level 2

1 elective

\*Some advanced students may have already taken the Earth Science credit in middle school or prefer to take the AP Earth Science credit during their 11<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> grade year, which is why most start with Biology\*

Cheat sheet to answer the question, "Should I double up?"

Band-yes

Vocal-yes

Orchestra-yes

Art-no

Theatre-(may go to the next level second semester, depending on skill)

Dance-(may go to the next level second semester, depending on skill)

ROTC-yes

World Language-yes, but not guaranteed to work out in scheduling

Math-not guaranteed to work out in scheduling

Science-not guaranteed to work out in scheduling; levels are dependent on Math level (Must have Math 2 complete before moving onto Chemistry)

Social Studies-no

English-no
