Jerome and Harriett Shain Evenson Scholarship in Education

The *Jerome and Harriett Shain Evenson Scholarship in Education* will be administered under the following guidelines:

- a. First preference will be given to an entering freshman, public school student from New Hanover County (NC). *This will be a one-time award and will not be renewable.*
- b. The recipient will be entering UNCG with the intention of becoming an education major.
- c. The recipient will demonstrate financial need.

Directions for Applying to the Evenson Scholarship

- 1. Apply and receive acceptance to the University of North Carolina at Greensboro (UNCG). Students must be accepted to UNCG by May 1st, 2017. Our office can verify student acceptance (no need to mail admissions documentation to our office).**
- 2. Fill out the Evenson Scholarship application. Deadline for applications to be received by our office is May 1st, 2019.**
- 3. Compose a personal statement following the directions found in the application. Deadline for personal statements to be received is May 1st, 2017.**
- 4. Complete an online Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Deadline for FAFSA completion is May 1st, 2017. Our office can verify the completion of the FAFSA form (no need to mail FAFSA materials to our office)**
- 5. Acquire an official sealed transcript from your high school with current grades and mail it to the address below by May 1st 2017. An additional transcript with your final grades will also need to be mailed to the address below by the end of the school year. Deadline for this transcript to be received by our office will be announced at a later date.**
- 6. Send your application, personal statement, and high school transcript to the following address:**
