All applications to be considered for scholarships are due by April 27<sup>th</sup>.

At that time our board will review all submitted applications and then notify chosen applicants for an in person interviews.

- 3) Tell us about your future plans.
- 4) Who has influenced you the most in your life and how did he/she change your thinking?
- 5) Have you volunteered with an organization and why did you choose them? What have you learned from your volunteering experience?
- 6) What are you passionate about? Where do you develop this passion?
- 7) What is your greatest strength? How can you use this strength to help others?
